Chor Bizarre, Bikaner House is drawing in the fasting crowd with its one-of-a-kind **Chironji ki Dal**, where legumes have been entirely replaced by chironji, the almond-flavoured seeds. Sharing space with it are **Vrat ki Raj Kachori**, **Arbi ke Kebab**, **Anar Pudina Raita** and **Sitaphal ka Halwa**. The more traditional fasting fare is not given a miss either. Menu entries like **Kuttu ka Parantha**, **Khatta Meetha Kaddu** and **Aloo Tamatar ki Sabzi** help widen the culinary catalogue.
